
Covid 19 Procedures



PLEASE READ Prior to Participation

We are all glad to be playing again, but in order to keep playing, teams and spectators MUST adhere to the common sense rules and suggestions. Upon purchasing either a daily or weekend pass the band will be handed to the spectator and be asked to put this on their wrist in front of the MELTDOWN staff member vs the usual protocol of Meltdown staff putting this onto someone. If their help is requested, they will be happy to help as in the past. Please keep and orderly distance of 6 feet while waiting.



COACHES

Gather your waivers from all your athletes prior to check in. We want to check in only one person per team.



COACHES & PARENTS

If you or any of your athletes are or have been sick, do NOT allow them to participate or attend.



COACHES & PARENTS

Please have your athletes refrain from giving 5. There are other ways to participate in good sportsmanship.



Each team provides a clock keeper (home team) and a book keeper (visitor). Each must wear a mask while at the table.



We recommend spectators to wear a face-mask while in the competition space but do not require at this time.



Staff & Referees will be temp checked and the basketballs will try to wipe down at all time outs, half time and between games.

Branson RecPlex Basketball Modifications and Recommendations Updated 6-25-2020

In an effort to maintain the safety of players and spectators during basketball events, the following modifications and recommendations will be put in place for all events:

 Anyone entering the building will be expected to have their temperature checked by tournament staff. Any player, coach or spectator with a temperature above 100.4 will not be allowed in the facility.



- All coaches are expected to inform their players and fans that they are not to attend if they are
 experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing and/or other symptoms of illness or
 if they have been exposed to someone with any of these symptoms.
- All spectators will be expected to adhere to social distancing recommendations. When seated,
 please maintain a reasonable distance from other family units. Bleacher seating will be available,
 and all spectators are encouraged to wipe down seating before and after use.
- Only players, coaches and officials will be allowed in designated play areas.
- Teams are asked to arrive no more than 30 minutes prior to their first scheduled game each day.
- At the conclusion of each game, teams will be required to leave the gymnasium area as quickly as possible to limit congestion.
- All post games team meetings should take place outside of the building in the parking lot area or on the back patio/pavilion area. Please do not have these meetings in the gymnasium or hallways.
- If teams have a scheduled break between games, they will be expected to leave the building and return for the later scheduled game. Teams should not remain in the gym if they are not playing.
- During games, each team will be limited to 2 coaches per bench to limit unnecessary congestion in the bench area.
- Benches will be spread out to allow additional space between seats. Only 8 seats will be available on each bench.
- Disinfectant and cleaning rags will be available at each scorer's table. Coaches are encouraged to wipe down all chairs before and after each game.
- Post games handshakes will not be allowed.
